52.219-28 Post-Award Small Business Program Rerepresentation.

As prescribed in 19.309(c)(1), insert the following clause:

Post-Award Small Business Program Rerepresentation (Feb 2024)

(a) Definitions. As used in this clause—

Long-term contract means a contract of more than five years in duration, including *options*. However, the term does not include contracts that exceed five years in duration because the period of performance has been extended for a cumulative period not to exceed six months under the clause at 52.217-8, *Option* to Extend Services, or other appropriate authority.

Small business concern—

- (1) Means a concern, including its *affiliates*, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in its field of operation, and qualified as a small business under the criteria in <u>13 CFR part 121</u> and the size standard in paragraph (d) of this clause.
- (2) *Affiliates*, as used in this definition, means business concerns, one of whom directly or indirectly controls or has the power to control the others, or a third party or parties control or have the power to control the others. In determining whether affiliation exists, consideration is given to all appropriate factors including common ownership, common management, and contractual relationships. SBA determines affiliation based on the factors set forth at 13 CFR 121.103.
- (b) If the Contractor represented that it was any of the *small business concerns* identified in 19.000(a)(3) prior to award of this contract, the Contractor *shall* rerepresent its size and socioeconomic status according to paragraph (f) of this clause or, if applicable, paragraph (h) of this clause, upon occurrence of any of the following:
- (1) Within 30 days after execution of a *novation agreement* or within 30 days after modification of the contract to include this clause, if the *novation agreement* was executed prior to inclusion of this clause in the contract.

- (i) Within 60 to 120 days prior to the end of the fifth year of the contract; and
- (ii) Within 60 to 120 days prior to the date specified in the contract for exercising any *option* thereafter.
- (c) If the Contractor represented that it was any of the *small business concerns* identified in 19.000(a)(3) prior to award of this contract, the Contractor *shall* rerepresent its size and socioeconomic status according to paragraph (f) of this clause or, if applicable, paragraph (h) of this clause, when the *Contracting Officer* explicitly requires it for an order issued under a *multiple-award*

contract.

- (d) The Contractor *shall* rerepresent its size status in accordance with the size standard in effect at the time of this rerepresentation that corresponds to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code(s) assigned to this contract. The small business size standard corresponding to this NAICS code(s) can be found at https://www.sba.gov/document/support--table-size-standards.
- (e) The small business size standard for a Contractor providing an end item that it does not manufacture, process, or produce itself, for a contract other than a *construction* or service contract, is 500 employees, or 150 employees for *information technology* value-added resellers under NAICS code 541519, if the *acquisition*—
- (1) Was set aside for small business and has a value above the simplified acquisition threshold;
- (2) Used the *HUBZone* price evaluation preference regardless of dollar value, unless the Contractor waived the price evaluation preference; or
- (3) Was an 8(a), *HUBZone*, service-disabled veteran-owned, economically disadvantaged women-owned, or women-owned small business set-aside or sole-source award regardless of dollar value.
- (f) Except as provided in paragraph (h) of this clause, the Contractor *shall* make the representation(s) required by paragraph (b) and (c) of this clause by validating or updating all its representations in the Representations and Certifications section of the *System for Award Management (SAM)* and its other data in SAM, as necessary, to ensure that they reflect the Contractor's current status.
