(7) PSC 9440, Miscellaneous Crude Agricultural and Forestry <i>Products</i> ;

(10) PSC 9630, Additive Metal Materials.
Place of manufacture means the place where an end product is assembled out of components, or otherwise made or processed from raw materials into the finished product that is to be provided to the Government. If a product is disassembled and reassembled, the place of reassembly is not the place of manufacture.
(b) For statistical purposes only, the <i>offeror shall</i> indicate whether the <i>place of manufacture</i> of the <i>end products</i> it expects to provide in response to this <i>solicitation</i> is predominantly-
(1) \square In the <i>United States</i> (Check this box if the total anticipated price of offered <i>end products</i> manufactured in the <i>United States</i> exceeds the total anticipated price of offered <i>end products</i> manufactured outside the <i>United States</i>); or
(2) \square Outside the <i>United States</i> .
