## 18.201 Contingency operation.

- (a) Contingency operation is defined in 2.101.
- (b) *Micro-purchase threshold*. The threshold increases when the *head of the agency* determines the *supplies* or services are to be used to support a *contingency operation*. (See 2.101 and 13.201(g).)
- (c) *Simplified acquisition threshold*. The threshold increases when the *head of the agency* determines the *supplies* or services are to be used to support a *contingency operation*. (See <u>2.101</u>.)
- (d) <u>SF 44</u>, *Purchase Order-Invoice-*Voucher. The normal threshold for the use of the <u>SF 44</u> is at or below the *micro-purchase threshold*. Agencies *may*, however, establish higher dollar limitations for purchases made to support a *contingency operation*. (See <u>13.306</u>.)
- (e) Simplified procedures for certain commercial products and commercial services. The threshold limits authorized for use of this authority may be increased for acquisitions to support a contingency operation. (See 13.500(c).)
