Subpart 225.72 - REPORTING CONTRACT PERFORMANCE OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES

Parent topic: Part 225 - FOREIGN ACQUISITION

225.7201 Policy.

 $\underline{10~\text{U.S.C.}~4603~\text{g}}$ requires offerors and contractors to notify DoD of any intention to perform any part of a DoD contract outside the United States and Canada that—

(a) Exceeds \$750,000 in value; and

(b) Could be performed inside the United States or Canada.

225.7202 Exception.

This subpart does not apply to contracts for commercial products, commercial services, construction, ores, natural gas, utilities, petroleum products and crudes, timber (logs), or subsistence.

225.7203 Contracting officer distribution of reports.

Follow the procedures at PGI $\underline{225.7203}$ for distribution of reports submitted with offers in accordance with the provision at $\underline{252.225-7003}$, Report of Intended Performance Outside the United States and Canada—Submission with Offer.

225.7204 Solicitation provision and contract clauses.

Except for acquisitions described in $\underline{225.7202}$ —

(a) Use the provision at 252.225-7003, Report of Intended Performance Outside the United States and Canada—Submission with Offer, in solicitations with a value exceeding \$15 million; and

(b) Use the clause at 252.225-7004, Report of Intended Performance Outside the United States and Canada—Submission after Award, in solicitations and contracts with a value exceeding \$15 million.
