## 541.204 GSA areawide contracts.

(a) The existence of a GSA areawide contract for the required service and location does not necessarily mean that the subject utility provider is the only source capable of meeting the requirement (see  $\underline{FAR}$   $\underline{41.202}$ (a) and  $\underline{41.204}$ (c)(1)). When market research and acquisition planning support ordering the entire requirement under an area-wide contract, the contracting officer may do so, but shall utilize the annual reviews required by  $\underline{FAR}$   $\underline{41.401}$  to determine the feasibility of later entering into a competitive contract for a portion of the requirement.

## (b) FAR Deviation.

- (1)Except as may be otherwise required by the terms of the areawide contract, and notwithstanding the requirement at  $\underline{FAR\ 41.204}(c)(1)$ , a bilateral written order is not required to establish new accounts or to pay for services rendered under an areawide contract.
- (2) Notwithstanding the requirement at  $\underline{FAR}$  41.204(c)(3), the contracting officer does not have to use the Standard Form 26.
- (3)Instead, GSA will follow the Regulated Utility Service Procedures set forth at <a href="https://insite.gsa.gov/utilityacquisition">https://insite.gsa.gov/utilityacquisition</a>.
