Subject: GSAR Case 2007-G505, Rewrite of GSAR Part 529, Taxes (Change 33)

- 1. <u>Purpose.</u> This order transmits a revision to the General Services Administration (GSAM).
- 2. <u>Background.</u> The General Services Administration amends the GSA Acquisition Manual (GSAM) to add coverage in GSAM Part 529, Taxes, to provide guidance in the areas of Policy and Application of State and local taxes to the Government. This guidance supplements the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) coverage provided in FAR Part 29.
- 3. Effective date. June 15, 2009.
- 4. Explanation of changes. Subpart 529.1 General, is added to direct contracting officers to FAR 29.101 (b) through (d) for the type of tax-related issues that require legal review. Additionally, it also directs contracting officers to the use of GSA Directive ADM 5000.4A, Legal Services, for legal reviews. Subpart 529.3 State and Local Taxes, is added to direct contracting officers to the appropriate area to obtain tax exemption information for GSA.

PART 529—TAXES

Subpart 529.1—General

529.101 Policy.

Action may not be taken on any matters involving taxes on Federal purchases or contracts without obtaining legal review. See ADM 5000.4A for the requirement to obtain legal review by the Office of General Counsel (OGC) for agency actions. See FAR 29.101 (b) through (d) for the type of tax-related issues that require legal review.

Subpart 529.3—State and Local Taxes

529.302 Application of State and local taxes to the Government.

If it has been determined that evidence of tax exemption is required, contracting officers shall follow the guidance as outlined on GSA Insite. Contracting officers shall input "Tax Exemption Information" in the search tool and then select "Tax Exemption Information" from the results list for point of contact information and GSA's tax exemption number.

Subpart 529.4—Contract Clauses

529.401 Domestic contracts.

529.401-70 Purchases at or under the simplified acquisition threshold.

Insert <u>552.229-70</u>, Federal, State, and Local Taxes, in purchases and contracts estimated to exceed the micropurchase threshold, but not the simplified acquisition threshold.

529.401-71 Contracts for supplies and services usable by the DC Government.

Insert <u>552.229-71</u>, Federal Excise Tax—DC Government, in solicitations and contracts that permit the District of Columbia Government to place orders.
